**HB 2112**, AN ACT concerning children and minors; relating to the revised Kansas code for care of children; enacting the Representative Gail Finney foster care bill of rights; establishing certain rights for children in need of care and foster parents.

**HB 2113**, AN ACT concerning expungement; relating to expungement under the Kansas code of procedure for municipal courts, the Kansas criminal code and the revised Kansas juvenile justice code; prohibiting denial of a petition for expungement due to the petitioner's inability to pay outstanding costs, fees, fines or restitution; providing that the waiting period for expungement starts on the date of conviction or adjudication; authorizing expungement of a juvenile adjudication if the juvenile has not committed a felony offense in the previous two years; amending K.S.A. 12-4516 and 38-2312 and K.S.A. 2022 Supp. 21-6614 and repealing the existing sections.
