**MEMORANDUM**

To: House Committee on Child Welfare and Foster Care

Date: February 20, 2023  
Subject: HB 2407: Creating conditions for the administration of certain tests, questionnaires, surveys and examinations and eliminating the parental consent requirements.

House Bill 2407 amends the statute that deals with nonacademic tests, questionnaire, surveys or examination concerning a student or such student's parent or guardians' personal beliefs or practices.

The statute would be amended to prohibit any nonacademic survey shall be administered to a student enrolled in kindergarten or one through 12 unless (1) such survey does not solicit personally identifiable information; (2) each student is informed that the survey is voluntary; (3) the parent or guardian receives notice of the administration of the survey; and (4) results are only reported as aggregate data.

Additionally, the section does not prohibit counselors or health professionals in school from administering surveys that are related to a student's receipt of services from such professional. Results from those surveys shall not be stored on mobile or electronic devices not owned by the school district.
