4 existing section. 5 6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 75-702 is hereby amended to read as follows: 75-7 702. (a) The attorney general shall appear for the state, and prosecute and 8 defend any and all actions and proceedings, civil or criminal, in the Kansas 9 supreme court, the Kansas court of appeals and in all federal courts, in 10 11 which the state shall be interested or a party, and shall, when so appearing, control the state's prosecution or defense. 12 (b) The attorney general shall also, when required by the governor or 13

either branch of the legislature, appear for the state and prosecute or defend, in any other court or before any officer, in any cause or matter, civil or criminal, in which this state may be a party or interested or when the constitutionality of any law of this state is at issue and when so directed shall seek final resolution of such issue in the supreme court of the state of Kansas.

20 (c) (1) The attorney general shall have authority to prosecute any 21 matter related to a violation of K.S.A. 12-189 or 75-5133, and amendment 22 *amendments* thereto, related to unlawful acts when the offender is an 23 officer or employee of a city or county.
