Subject: **HB 2196: Expanding deferred retirement option program (DROP) membership to all Kansas police and firemen's retirement system members.**

House Bill No. 2196 amends the definition of "member" for the deferred retirement option program (DROP) within the Kansas police and firemen's retirement system (KP&F) to include any member of KP&F. Under current law, a member of DROP can only be a trooper, examiner or officer of the Kansas highway patrol or an agent of the Kansas bureau of investigation. Under K.S.A. 74-4986r, the DROP is set to expire on January 1, 2025.

The bill becomes effective upon publication in the statute book.
