Chair Sutton and Members of the Committee,

My name is Mike Wasmer, and I am the Chief Operating Officer for the Council of Autism Service Providers (CASP). CASP is a non-profit trade association of autism service provider organizations that have demonstrated a commitment to providing evidence-based services, such as applied behavior analysis, to individuals with autism.

I am a resident of Olathe and the father of a young adult with autism. On behalf of CASP and personally, as a past consumer of autism services and an advocate for Kansas families impacted by autism, I support the passage of SB 24.

Along with many other parent advocates, I was involved in the passage of the autism insurance bill in 2014. The insurance lobby inserted language redefining large and small employers in anticipation of the implementation of a provision of the Affordable Care Act that would define "small employer" in *all states* as having up to 100 employees.

The federal PACE Act passed in 2015 and amended this provision, giving states the *option* to expand the definition of "small employer." Kansas opted to keep its statutory definition of "small employer" as having 2-50 employees. (KSA 40-2209d)

To my knowledge, the autism insurance statute (KSA 40-2,194) is the only Kansas statute that uses a different definition of "small employer." Because of the challenge of implementing a plan with two different definitions of small employer, it is my understanding that payers have not been enforcing the autism benefit using the restricted definition (i.e., limiting coverage to beneficiaries working for companies with >100 employees).

However, for consumers and advocates assisting families impacted by autism, the definition of small employer in KSA 40-2,194 remains a significant source of confusion. I appreciate the committee addressing this issue and ask for your support of SB 24.
