We support your desire for excellence in the classroom and strongly believe that this is only achieved with the rigorous training of teachers, whether it be in post secondary teacher education or alternative programs. While teacher recruitment is one of the three main areas of interest for Topeka Public Schools – USD 501, we believe that there needs to be rigorous criteria, and approval for such alternative teacher certification programs. It seems logical that **all** criteria and approval should fall to the State Board of Education as they are the entity that would be **required** to do the licensing.
