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Madam Chair and Members of the Committee,

KASB appears today in opposition to HB 2521. Our opposition is based on our member-affirmed policies.

Our 2024 Resolution states that we support the State Board of Education's professional licensing standards for teachers and substitute teachers. Our Permanent Policies state, "KASB supports alternative routes to teacher and administrator licensure *for those who have not received traditional pedagogical training in a college of education*" (emphasis added).

Kansas currently has several alternative routes to teacher licensure, under the auspices of the State Board of Education. As a result, we feel this bill is unnecessary and duplicative.

Additionally, we're troubled by HB 2521's specific prohibition on requiring prospective teachers to have any pedagogical training. This provision is ill advised and would deprive Kansas students of the highly qualified teachers they deserve and who will prepare them for a bright future.

For these reasons, we ask the committee to reject HB 2521. Thank you.
