WANRack stands in support of HB 2106. HB 2106 would provide a sales tax exemption for sales of property and services used in the provision of communications services.

Currently broadband providers are actively working to provide access to consumers across the State, at a time when its services are becoming more critical. One way to assist in making services more accessible, is by creating a pro-business/pro-tax environment for telecommunications providers across the State. HB 2106 helps decrease the cost to deploy telecommunications infrastructure. This deployment is necessary to provide broadband services to more areas in need of increased connectivity.

Unfortunately, companies do not have unlimited capital budgets. Costs continue to skyrocket due to supply chain challenges, capital intensive projects taking shape across the US simultaneously and inflation, among other factors. This investment will allow more communities, many of which are rural, to have increased access to high-speed internet, a necessity in today's global economy.
