 - -Lack of transparency of financial data (No disclosure of facts...

Forms of Bullying - Not just one time incidents, but repeated offenses.

- -Physical paying for 50% of expenses without receiving fair share of services...Lowry, "It's always been done this way..." from Kenny B. email or letter?
- -EXCLUSION..suppression of communication (Jan. vote to remove meeting location rotation) Lack of proper BOE representation."We'll fix it after the vote..."
- -Lies & Rumors ...enrollment declines...all schools will be closed...any of the **propaganda** mailed out before the disorganization vote. I have most mailers.
- -Threats -Salary inequities... don't complain or reprimanded...Shelly Sebesta and public notice to parents about Jan. 4th hearing

Fear of job loss (implied or real)
