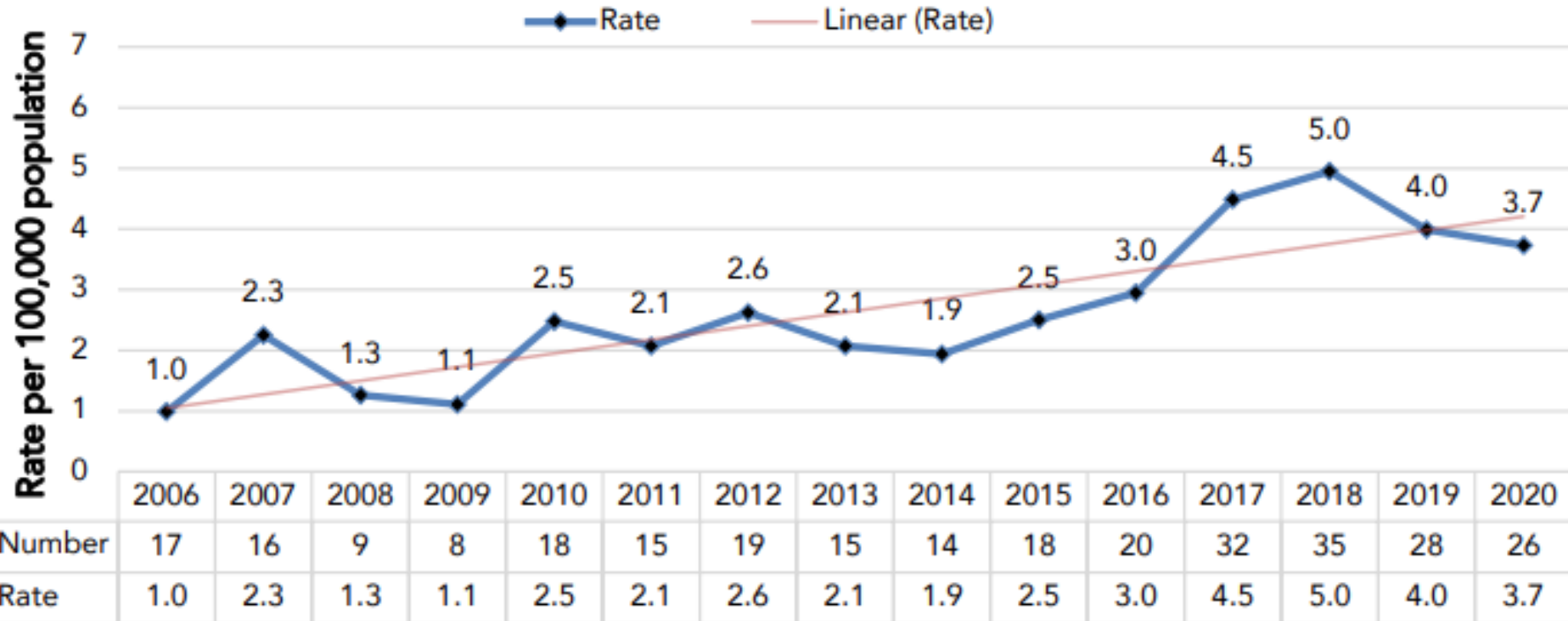

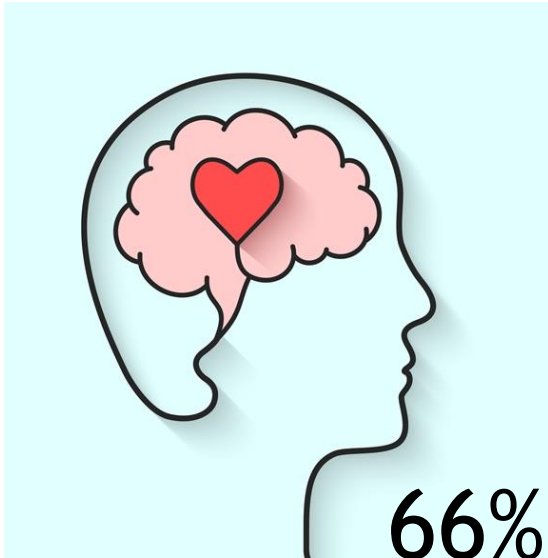


# Data- 2022 Kansas Child Death Review Board *age 0-17*

**Suicide Death Rates, Ages 0-17, 2006 - 2020**

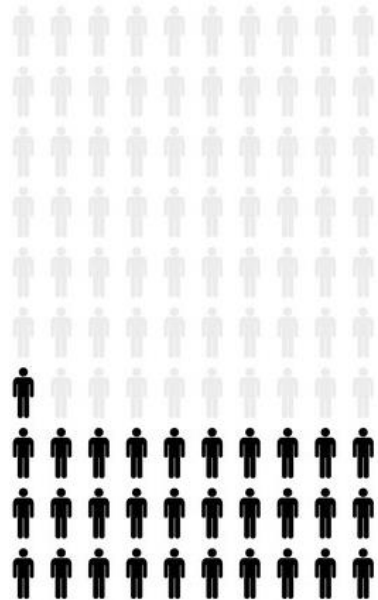


# Data- 2022 Kansas Child Death Review Board *age 0-17*

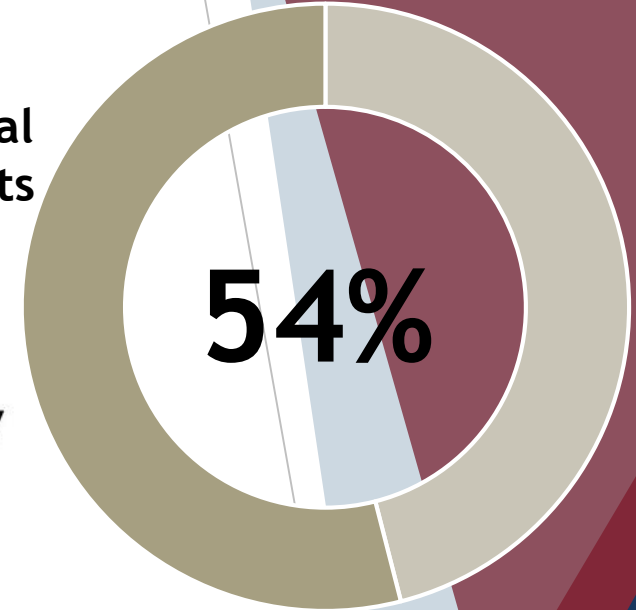
66% of 10-17 year old Kansas youth that died by suicide were currently or previously had received mental health services



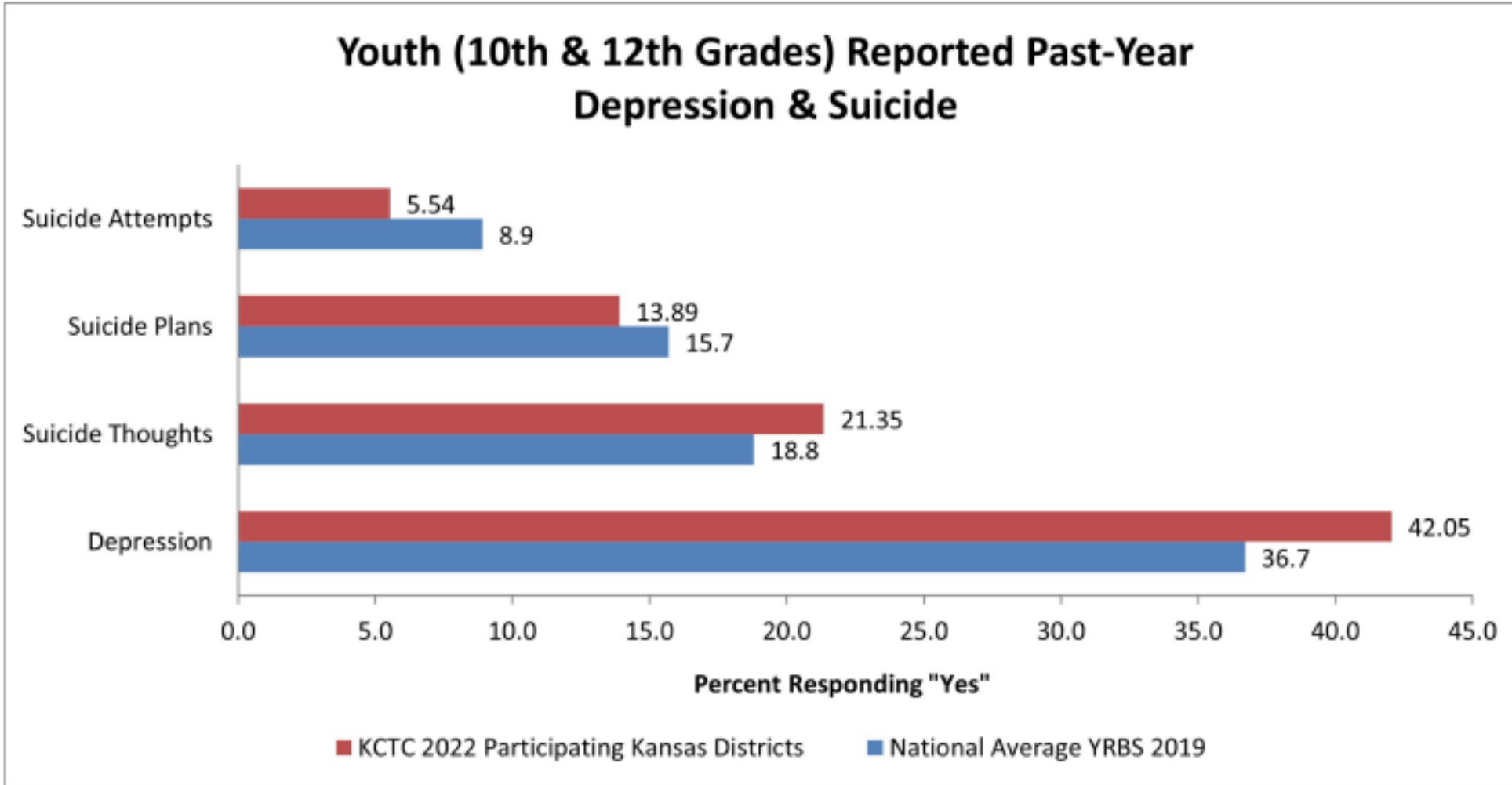
31%

31% were known to have attempted suicide previously.

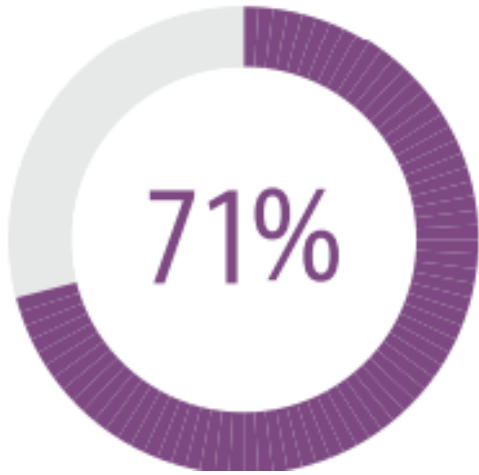
54% communicated suicidal thoughts, actions or intents

# Data- 2016-2020 KDHE Suicide Statistics ages 10-17



More than 3 in 4 (71%) of violent deaths<sup>1</sup> among people 10 to 17 years and old in Kansas were suicides.



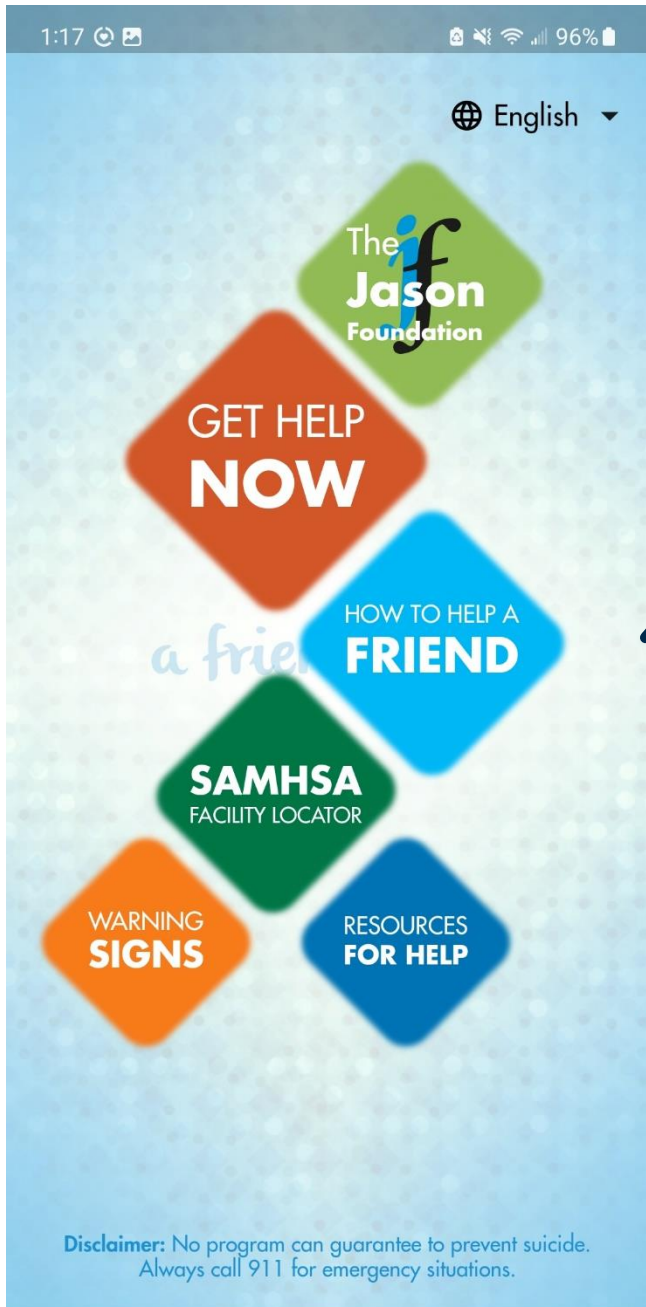
About 1 in 4 (25%) of those aged 10-17 who died by suicide were in 8th grade or less.



3 in 10 (30%) had a crisis within the 2 weeks prior to death.
