
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2625 by House Committee on Veterans and Military

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2625 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2625 would prohibit state agencies and municipalities from requesting or demanding any document or improvising an authentication procedure, other than those specifically listed, for the purpose of determining eligibility for any benefit derived from a service-connected disability suffered by a Kansas veteran. The bill would also include related definitions.

According to the Kansas Commission on Veterans Affairs Office and the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services enactment of HB 2625 would not have a fiscal effect for either agency.
