AN ACT concerning traffic regulations; relating to operating a vehicle 1 2 while fatigued; creating a traffic infraction thereof; amending K.S.A. 8-3 2118 and repealing the existing section. 4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 5 6 New Section 1. (a) No person shall operate a vehicle while such 7 person's ability or alertness is so impaired by fatigue as to make it unsafe 8 to begin or continue to operate a vehicle. 9 (b) This section shall be a part of and supplemental to the uniform act 10 regulating traffic on highways. 11 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 8-2118 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-2118. 12 (a) A person charged with a traffic infraction shall, except as provided in 13 subsection (b), appear at the place and time specified in the notice to appear. If the person enters an appearance, waives right to trial, pleads 14 guilty or no contest, the fine shall be no greater than that specified in the 15 uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs shall be taxed as 16 17 provided by law. 18 (b) Prior to the time specified in the notice to appear, a person 19 charged with a traffic infraction may enter a written appearance, waive 20 right to trial, plead guilty or no contest and pay the fine for the violation as 21 specified in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs 22 provided by law. Payment may be made in any manner accepted by the 23 court. The traffic citation shall not have been complied with if the payment 24 is not honored for any reason, or if the fine and court costs are not paid in full. When a person charged with a traffic infraction makes payment 25 26 without executing a written waiver of right to trial and plea of guilty or no 27 contest, the payment shall be deemed such an appearance, waiver of right 28 to trial and plea of no contest. 29 The following uniform fine schedule shall apply uniformly (c) 30 throughout the state but shall not limit the fine that may be imposed 31 following a court appearance, except an appearance made for the purpose

32 of pleading and payment as permitted by subsection (a). The description of 33 offense contained in the following uniform fine schedule is for reference 34 only and is not a legal definition.

5 (d) Traffic offenses classified as traffic infractions by this section 6 shall be classified as ordinance traffic infractions by those cities adopting 7 ordinances prohibiting the same offenses. A schedule of fines for all 8 ordinance traffic infractions shall be established by the municipal judge in 9 the manner prescribed by K.S.A. 12-4305, and amendments thereto. Such 10 fines may vary from those contained in the uniform fine schedule 11 contained in subsection (c).

(e) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c) shall be doubled if a person is convicted of a traffic infraction, which is defined as a moving violation in accordance with rules and regulations adopted pursuant to K.S.A. 8-249, and amendments thereto, committed within any road construction zone as defined in K.S.A. 8-1458a, and amendments thereto.

18 (f) For a second violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and 19 amendments thereto, within two years after a prior conviction of K.S.A. 8-20 1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction 21 shall be fined $1^{1}/_{2}$ times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of 22 the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection 23 (c). For a third violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments 24 thereto, within two years, after two prior convictions of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 25 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction shall be fined two times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of the 26 27 schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c). 28 For a fourth and each succeeding violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, 29 and amendments thereto, within two years after three prior convictions of 30 K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon 31 conviction shall be fined $2^{1/2}$ times the applicable amount from one, but 32 not both, of the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in 33 subsection (c).

(g) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection
(c) relating to exceeding the maximum speed limit, shall be doubled if a
person is convicted of exceeding the maximum speed limit in a school
zone authorized under K.S.A. 8-1560(a)(4), and amendments thereto.

(h) For a second violation of K.S.A. 8-1556, and amendments thereto,
within five years after a prior conviction of K.S.A. 8-1556, and
amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction, shall be fined \$750 for
the second violation. For a third and each succeeding violation of K.S.A.
8-1556, and amendments thereto, within five years after two prior
convictions of K.S.A. 8-1556, and amendments thereto, such person, upon

- 1 conviction, shall be fined \$1,000 for the third and each succeeding 2 violation.
- 3 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 8-2118 is hereby repealed.
- 4 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 5 publication in the statute book.
