Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 2022 Supp. 23-2716 is hereby amended to read as follows: 23-2716. (a) Upon the request of a spouse, the court shall order the restoration of that spouse's—maiden or former name. The court shall have jurisdiction to restore the spouse's—maiden or former name at or after the time the decree of divorce becomes final.

- (b) Upon the request of a spouse, the court may order such spouse's name be changed to a name that is different than such spouse's maiden or former name. The court shall have jurisdiction to change the spouse's name at or after the time the decree of divorce becomes final.
- (c) The judicial council shall develop a form—which that is simple, concise and direct for use with this paragraph section.
- Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2022 Supp. 23-2716 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book *Kansas register*.
