AN ACT concerning traffic regulations; relating to the uniform fine
 schedule for traffic infractions; increasing penalties for operating a
 vehicle in excess of 30 miles per hour over the speed limit; amending
 K.S.A. 8-2118 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 8-2118 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-2118. (a) A person charged with a traffic infraction shall, except as provided in subsection (b), appear at the place and time specified in the notice to appear. If the person enters an appearance, waives right to trial, pleads guilty or no contest, the fine shall be no greater than that specified in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs shall be taxed as provided by law.

14 (b) Prior to the time specified in the notice to appear, a person 15 charged with a traffic infraction may enter a written appearance, waive 16 right to trial, plead guilty or no contest and pay the fine for the violation as specified in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs 17 18 provided by law. Payment may be made in any manner accepted by the 19 court. The traffic citation shall not have been complied with if the payment 20 is not honored for any reason, or if the fine and court costs are not paid in 21 full. When a person charged with a traffic infraction makes payment 22 without executing a written waiver of right to trial and plea of guilty or no 23 contest, the payment shall be deemed such an appearance, waiver of right 24 to trial and plea of no contest.

(c) The following uniform fine schedule shall apply uniformly throughout the state but shall not limit the fine that may be imposed following a court appearance, except an appearance made for the purpose of pleading and payment as permitted by subsection (a). The description of offense contained in the following uniform fine schedule is for reference only and is not a legal definition.

43	shall be classified as ordinance to	raffic infractions b	y those cities adopting

ordinances prohibiting the same offenses. A schedule of fines for all
 ordinance traffic infractions shall be established by the municipal judge in
 the manner prescribed by K.S.A. 12-4305, and amendments thereto. Such
 fines may vary from those contained in the uniform fine schedule
 contained in subsection (c).

6 (e) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in-subsection 7 *subsections* (c) *and (i)* shall be doubled if a person is convicted of a traffic 8 infraction, which *that* is defined as a moving violation in accordance with 9 rules and regulations adopted pursuant to K.S.A. 8-249, and amendments 10 thereto, committed within any road construction zone as defined in K.S.A. 11 8-1458a, and amendments thereto.

12 (f) For a second violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and 13 amendments thereto, within two years after a prior conviction of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction, 14 shall be fined $1^{1}/_{2}$ times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of 15 16 the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection 17 (c). For a third violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments 18 thereto, within two years, after two prior convictions of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 19 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction, shall be 20 fined two times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of the 21 schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c). 22 For a fourth and each succeeding violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, 23 and amendments thereto, within two years after three prior convictions of 24 K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon 25 conviction, shall be fined $2^{1/2}$ times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in 26 27 subsection (c).

(g) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in-subsection *subsections* (c) *and* (*i*) relating to exceeding the maximum speed limit,
shall be doubled if a person is convicted of exceeding the maximum speed
limit in a school zone authorized under K.S.A. 8-1560(a)(4), and
amendments thereto.

33 (h) For a second violation of K.S.A. 8-1556, and amendments thereto, 34 within five years after a prior conviction of K.S.A. 8-1556, and 35 amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction, shall be fined \$750 for 36 the second violation. For a third and each succeeding violation of K.S.A. 37 8-1556, and amendments thereto, within five years after two prior 38 convictions of K.S.A. 8-1556, and amendments thereto, such person, upon 39 conviction, shall be fined \$1,000 for the third and each succeeding 40 violation.

41 *(i) (1)* For a second violation of K.S.A. 8-1558 through 8-1560b, and 42 amendments thereto, for operating a vehicle at a speed in excess of 30 43 miles per hour over the speed limit within five years after a prior 1 conviction of K.S.A. 8-1558 through 8-1560b, and amendments thereto, for

2 operating a vehicle at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour over the

3 speed limit, such person, upon conviction, shall be fined \$750 plus \$25 for
4 each mile per hour over 30 miles per hour.

5 (2) For a third and each succeeding violation of K.S.A. 8-1558 6 through 8-1560b, and amendments thereto, for operating a vehicle at a 7 speed in excess of 30 miles per hour over the speed limit within five years 8 after two or more prior convictions of K.S.A. 8-1558 through 8-1560b, and 9 amendments thereto, for operating a vehicle at a speed in excess of 30

10 miles per hour over the speed limit, such person, upon conviction, shall be

11 fined \$1,000 plus \$30 for each mile per hour over 30 miles per hour.

12 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 8-2118 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after itspublication in the statute book.
