AN ACT concerning federal rules and regulations; relating to enforcement by state agencies; prohibiting enforcement without approval of the legislature of the state of Kansas.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) To ensure that the powers reserved to this state under amendment X to the constitution of the United States are protected and to ensure that the federal government does not encroach on this state's status as an independent sovereign in a federal system of governance, all federal rules and regulations shall be subject to review.

- (b) No department or agency of this state shall enforce any rule or regulation promulgated by any federal agency within the borders of this state unless the enforcement of such regulation is approved by the legislature of the state of Kansas.
- (c) No rule or regulation shall be promulgated by any department or agency of this state in conjunction with the enforcement of any regulation promulgated by any federal agency unless such rule or regulation is approved by the legislature of the state of Kansas.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
