Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, each person, board, commission or similar body that determines the qualifications of individuals for licensure, certification or registration in the state of Kansas shall issue an exemption from such body's continuing education for the period of licensure to a licensee upon application if the licensee:

- (1) Holds a current and valid license issued by any body that determines the qualifications of individuals for licensure for any occupation in the state of Kansas; and
- (2) self-certifies to performing not less than 1,000 hours in the lawful occupation during each period of licensure.
- (b) Each person, board, commission or similar body that determines the qualifications of individuals for licensure, certification or registration in the state of Kansas shall adopt rules and regulations or guidelines implementing the provisions of this section.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
