## HOUSE BILL No. 2441

AN ACT concerning firearms; creating the anti-red flag gun seizure act; 1 2 prohibiting the enforcement of any law, regulation or order that prohibits the possession of a firearm in violation of amendment II to the 3 4 constitution of the United States; providing a cause of action and civil 5 penalties for violations of the act. 6 7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 8 Section 1. (a) The provisions of this section shall be known and may 9 be cited as the anti-red flag gun seizure act. 10 (b) As used in this section: 11 (1) (A) "Material aid and support" includes voluntarily giving or allowing others to make use of lodging, communications equipment or 12 13 services, including social media accounts, facilities, weapons, personnel, transportation, clothing or other physical assets; and 14 (B) "material aid and support" does not include giving or allowing the 15 16 use of medicine or other materials necessary to treat physical injuries or any assistance provided to help persons escape a serious, present risk of 17 18 life-threatening injury; and 19 (2) "red flag law" means: 20 (A) Any law, rule and regulation or executive order that directs the 21 temporary or permanent seizure of any firearm, firearm accessory or 22 ammunition of an individual without the adjudication of a competent 23 court: or 24 (B) any federal statute, rule, regulation, executive order or judicial 25 order or any state statute, rule and regulation, executive order or judicial 26 order that: 27 (i) Prohibits a citizen of this state from owning, possessing, 28 transporting, transferring or receiving any firearm, firearm accessory or 29 ammunition unless such individual is prohibited from possessing a firearm 30 under K.S.A. 2022 Supp. 21-6304, and amendments thereto, or K.S.A. 75-31 7c25, and amendments thereto; or 32 (ii) requires the seizure of any firearm, firearm accessory or 33 ammunition from a citizen of this state or a surrender of such by a citizen 34 of this state unless such individual is prohibited from possessing a firearm 35 under K.S.A. 2022 Supp. 21-6304, and amendments thereto, or K.S.A. 75-36 7c25, and amendments thereto.

1 (c) Any federal law, rule, regulation, executive, administrative or iudicial order that is a red flag law shall be considered an infringement on 2 3 the people's right to keep and bear arms as guaranteed by amendment II to 4 the constitution of the United States and section 4 of the bill of rights of 5 the constitution of the state of Kansas and an infringement on the right to 6 due process as guaranteed by amendments V and XIV to the constitution 7 of the United States and sections 10, 15 and 18 of the bill of rights of the 8 constitution of the state of Kansas. Any such law, rule, regulation or order 9 shall be invalid and unenforceable in this state.

10 (d) No state agency, political subdivision or state or municipal law enforcement agency shall receive or expend any federal moneys for the 11 12 purpose of enforcing any red flag law against a citizen of this state or any 13 federal or state law, rule, regulation or order that would have the effect of enforcing a red flag law against a citizen of this state. No state agency, 14 political subdivision or municipal law enforcement agency or any 15 16 employee thereof shall have the authority to enforce or attempt to enforce 17 a red flag law. Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to prohibit any 18 agent of the federal government from enforcing any federal law, rule, 19 regulation or order.

20 (e) (1) Any law enforcement agency or political subdivision of this 21 state that employs a law enforcement officer who violates this section 22 while acting under the color of any state law, rule and regulation or 23 executive, administrative or judicial order shall be liable to the individual 24 against whom the red flag law was enforced for any damages resulting 25 from such violation and subject to a civil penalty of \$50,000 for each 26 occurrence. Each violation with respect to a firearm, firearm accessoary or 27 container of ammunition shall constitute a separate occurrence.

28 (2) Any law enforcement agency or political subdivision of this state 29 that employs an individual, acting or who previously acted as an official, agent, employee or deputy of the government of the United States, or 30 31 otherwise acted under the color of federal law within the borders of this 32 state after the effective date of this section, who enforced or attempted to 33 enforce any red flag law or gave material aid and support to the efforts of 34 another individual or agency of the government of the United States who 35 enforced or attempted to enforce any red flag law shall be subject to a civil 36 penalty of \$50,000 for each such employee.

(3) Any individual aggrieved by a violation of this section may bring
an action in a court of competent jurisdiction for injunctive and other
relief. Upon the filing of a motion for a temporary or permanent
injunction, the court shall hold a hearing on such motion within 30 days of
service of such motion on the defendant.

42 (4) The court may award reasonable attorney fees and court costs to 43 the prevailing party in any action filed pursuant to this section unless such

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- prevailing party is the state of Kansas or any political subdivision thereof. (5) Sovereign immunity shall not be an affirmative defense in any action filed pursuant to this section. 2 3
