1 AN ACT concerning education; relating to firearms; standardizing firearm
2 safety education training programs in school districts.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. (a) For the purposes of promoting the safety and protection
6 of students and emphasizing how students should respond when
7 encountering a firearm, the board of education of a school district may
8 provide firearm safety education programs. The state board of education
9 shall establish curriculum guidelines for a standardized firearm safety
10 education program. Such guidelines shall include, but not be limited to,
11 accident prevention and, for students enrolled in:

12 (1) Kindergarten and grades one through five, shall be based on the
13 eddie eagle gunsafe program offered by the national rifle association or
14 any successor program;

15 (2) grades six through eight, shall be based on the eddie eagle gunsafe
16 program offered by the national rifle association or any successor program
17 or the hunter education in our schools program offered by the Kansas
18 department of wildlife and parks or any successor program; and

19 (3) grades nine through 12, shall be based on the hunter education in
20 our schools program offered by the Kansas department of wildlife and
21 parks or any successor program.

22 (b) If a board of education elects to provide firearm safety education,
23 such instruction shall be in accordance with the guidelines established by
24 the state board of education and shall be offered to ensure that all students
25 are provided the opportunity to take the course.

26 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
27 publication in the statute book.
