AN ACT concerning traffic regulations; relating to the duty of drivers
 approaching stationary vehicles; providing a penalty for unlawful
 passing thereof; prohibiting the use of a mobile telephone while
 operating a vehicle in a school zone or a road construction zone or
 by individuals under 18 years of age; amending K.S.A. 8-2118 and
 repealing the existing section.

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

9 New Section 1. (a) The driver of a motor vehicle, upon approaching a 10 stopped, standing or parked vehicle that is displaying hazard warning 11 signal lamps, road flares or caution signals, including traffic cones, caution 12 signs or reflective triangles, shall do either of the following:

13 (1) If the driver of the motor vehicle is traveling on a highway that 14 consists of at least two lanes that carry traffic in the same direction of 15 travel as that of the driver's motor vehicle, the driver shall proceed with 16 due caution and, if possible and with due regard to the road, weather and 17 traffic conditions, shall change lanes into a lane that is not adjacent to that 18 of the stationary vehicle; or

(2) if the driver is not traveling on a highway of a type described in
paragraph (1), or if the driver is traveling on a highway of that type but it
is not possible to change lanes or if to do so would be unsafe, the driver
shall proceed with due caution, reduce the speed of the motor vehicle and
maintain a safe speed for the road, weather and traffic conditions.

(b) This section shall be a part of and supplemental to the uniform actregulating traffic on highways.

New Sec. 2. (a) No person under the age of 18 years of age shall
use a mobile telephone while operating a motor vehicle.

(b) No person shall use a mobile telephone while operating a motor vehicle in a school zone at a time when a reduced speed limit is enforced as established by K.S.A. 8-1560(a) or 8-1560e, and amendments thereto, or in a road construction zone, as that term is defined in K.S.A. 8-1458a, and amendments thereto, while workers are present.

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(c) The provisions of subsections (a) and (b) shall not apply to:

35 (1) A law enforcement officer or emergency service personnel 36 acting within the course and scope of the law enforcement officer's or 1 emergency service personnel's employment;

2 (2) a person operating a motor vehicle that is halted at a location 3 where the vehicle can safely and lawfully remain stationary; or

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(3) a mobile telephone that is being used with a hands-free device.

5 (d) The provisions of subsections (a) or (b) shall not prohibit a 6 person from using a mobile telephone while operating a motor vehicle 7 that would otherwise violate subsections (a) or (b) to:

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(1) Report current or ongoing illegal activity to law enforcement;

(2) prevent imminent injury to a person or property;

(3) summon medical or other emergency assistance; or

(4) relay information between a transit or for-hire operator and
 the operator's dispatcher, if the device is permanently affixed to the
 motor vehicle.

14 (e) Holding a mobile telephone shall constitute prima facie 15 evidence of a violation of:

(1) Subsection (a) for persons under the age of 18 years of age; or

17 (2) subsection (b) for persons operating a motor vehicle in a18 school zone or a road construction zone.

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(f) As used in this section:

(1) "Hands-free device" means speakerphone capability or a
telephone attachment or other piece of equipment, regardless of
whether or not the hands-free device is permanently installed in the
motor vehicle, that allows use of the mobile telephone without use of
either of the operator's hands.

(2) "Mobile telephone" does not include a commercial two-way
 radio communication device or its functional equivalent, subscription based emergency communication device, prescribed medical device,
 amateur or ham radio device or remote diagnostics system.

(g) A law enforcement officer shall issue a warning citation to
anyone violating the provisions of subsections (a) or (b). The
provisions of this subsection shall expire and have no effect on and
after July 1, 2025.

(h) This section shall be a part of and supplemental to the
 uniform act regulating traffic on highways.

Sec. $\underline{-2}$: **3.** K.S.A. 8-2118 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-2118. (a) A person charged with a traffic infraction shall, except as provided in subsection (b), appear at the place and time specified in the notice to appear. If the person enters an appearance, waives right to trial, pleads guilty or no contest, the fine shall be no greater than that specified in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs shall be taxed as provided by law.

42 (b) Prior to the time specified in the notice to appear, a person 43 charged with a traffic infraction may enter a written appearance, waive

right to trial, plead guilty or no contest and pay the fine for the violation as 1 2 specified in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs 3 provided by law. Payment may be made in any manner accepted by the court. The traffic citation shall not have been complied with if the payment 4 is not honored for any reason, or if the fine and court costs are not paid in 5 6 full. When a person charged with a traffic infraction makes payment 7 without executing a written waiver of right to trial and plea of guilty or no 8 contest, the payment shall be deemed such an appearance, waiver of right 9 to trial and plea of no contest.

10 (c) The following uniform fine schedule shall apply uniformly 11 throughout the state but shall not limit the fine that may be imposed 12 following a court appearance, except an appearance made for the purpose 13 of pleading and payment as permitted by subsection (a). The description of 14 offense contained in the following uniform fine schedule is for reference 15 only and is not a legal definition.

(d) Iraffic offenses classified as traffic infractions by this section
shall be classified as ordinance traffic infractions by those cities adopting
ordinances prohibiting the same offenses. A schedule of fines for all
ordinance traffic infractions shall be established by the municipal judge in
the manner prescribed by K.S.A. 12-4305, and amendments thereto. Such
fines may vary from those contained in the uniform fine schedule
contained in subsection (c).

(e) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection
(c) shall be doubled if a person is convicted of a traffic infraction, which is
defined as a moving violation in accordance with rules and regulations
adopted pursuant to K.S.A. 8-249, and amendments thereto, committed
within any road construction zone as defined in K.S.A. 8-1458a, and
amendments thereto.

36 (f) For a second violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and 37 amendments thereto, within two years after a prior conviction of K.S.A. 8-38 1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction 39 shall be fined $1^{1}/_{2}$ times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection 40 41 (c). For a third violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments 42 thereto, within two years, after two prior convictions of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction shall be 43

1 fined two times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c). 2 3 For a fourth and each succeeding violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, 4 and amendments thereto, within two years after three prior convictions of 5 K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon 6 conviction shall be fined $2^{1/2}$ times the applicable amount from one, but 7 not both, of the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in 8 subsection (c).

9 (g) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection 10 (c) relating to exceeding the maximum speed limit, shall be doubled if a 11 person is convicted of exceeding the maximum speed limit in a school 12 zone authorized under K.S.A. 8-1560(a)(4), and amendments thereto.

13 (h) For a second violation of K.S.A. 8-1556, and amendments thereto, within five years after a prior conviction of K.S.A. 8-1556, and 14 15 amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction, shall be fined \$750 for 16 the second violation. For a third and each succeeding violation of K.S.A. 8-1556, and amendments thereto, within five years after two prior 17 18 convictions of K.S.A. 8-1556, and amendments thereto, such person, upon 19 conviction, shall be fined \$1,000 for the third and each succeeding 20 violation.

21 Sec.<u>3.</u> **4.** K.S.A. 8-2118 is hereby repealed.

22 Sec.<u>4.</u> **5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 23 publication in the statute book.
