AN ACT concerning health and healthcare; establishing the KanCare
bridge to a healthy Kansas program; relating to medical assistance;
expanding income limits for eligibility to 138% of the federal poverty
level.

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

7 Section 1. (a) This section shall be known and may be cited as the 8 KanCare bridge to a healthy Kansas program, and the KanCare bridge to a 9 healthy Kansas program is hereby established. The department of health 10 and environment shall administer and promote the program and provide 11 information to potential eligible individuals who live in medically 12 underserved areas of Kansas. The legislature expressly consents to expand 13 eligibility for receipt of benefits under the Kansas program of medical 14 assistance as required by K.S.A. 39-709(e)(2), and amendments thereto, by the passage and enactment of the KanCare bridge to a healthy Kansas 15 16 program.

17 (b) For the purposes of eligibility determinations under the Kansas 18 program of medical assistance on and after January 1, 2024, medical 19 assistance shall be granted to any adult under 65 years of age who is not 20 pregnant and whose modified adjusted gross income does not exceed 21 138% of the federal poverty level, to the extent permitted under the 22 provisions of 42 U.S.C. § 1396a, as in effect on July 1, 2023.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after itspublication in the statute book.
