AN ACT concerning income taxation; relating to Kansas exemptions for 1 2 an individual; providing additional exemptions for unborn children 3 with a detectable heartbeat; amending K.S.A. 2022 Supp. 79-32,121 4 and repealing the existing section. 5

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 2022 Supp. 79-32,121 is hereby amended to read as 8 follows: 79-32,121. (a) An individual shall be allowed a Kansas exemption 9 of \$2,250 for each exemption for which such individual is entitled to a 10 deduction for the taxable year for federal income tax purposes.

11 (b) In addition to the exemptions provided in subsection (a), any individual who has been honorably discharged from active service in any 12 13 branch of the armed forces of the United States and who is certified by the United States department of veterans affairs or its successor to be in 14 15 receipt of disability compensation at the 100% rate, if the disability is 16 permanent and was sustained through military action or accident or resulted from disease contracted while in such active service, such 17 18 individual shall be allowed an additional Kansas exemption of \$2,250 for 19 tax year 2023 and all tax years thereafter.

20 (c) (1) In addition to the exemptions provided in subsections (a) and 21 (b), for tax year 2024 and all tax years thereafter, any individual who is 22 pregnant with an unborn child with a detectable heartbeat at any time 23 during such tax year shall be allowed an additional Kansas exemption of 24 \$2,250. Such an additional exemption shall be allowed for each unborn 25 child with a detectable heartbeat carried by the individual during such tax 26 vear.

(2) For purposes of this subsection:

28 (A) "Detectable heartbeat" means embryonic or fetal cardiac activity 29 or the steady and repetitive rhythmic contraction of the heart within the 30 gestational sac; and

31 (B) "unborn child" means a member of the species homo sapiens at 32 any stage of development who is carried in the womb and who has a 33 detectable heartbeat. 34

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2022 Supp. 79-32,121 is hereby repealed.
