SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 340

As Recommended by Senate Committee on Financial Institutions and Insurance

Brief*

SB 340 would amend the definition of "person" in law regarding violations of insurance law by removing references to specific entities under the jurisdiction of the Commissioner of Insurance (Commissioner) for the purpose of determining violations of Kansas insurance law.

Background

The bill was introduced by the Senate Committee on Financial Institutions and Insurance at the request of a representative of the Kansas Insurance Department (Department). [Note: A companion bill, HB 2530, has been introduced in the House.]

Senate Committee on Financial Institutions and Insurance

In the Senate Committee hearing, **proponent** testimony was provided by a representative of the Department. The representative indicated the bill would eliminate the reference of automobile club in the definition of "person", as automobile clubs are no longer under the jurisdiction of the Commissioner.

No other testimony was provided.
