Agency Estimate

The **agency** requests a revised estimate of \$38.8 million, all from special revenue funds, in expenditures and 135.25 FTE positions in FY 2024. This is a decrease of \$605,761, or 1.5 percent, below the FY 2024 approved amount. The decrease is primarily attributable to a drop in expenditures for professional services, specifically accountants and auditors who assist in regulating insurance companies. The agency also notes that it was not able to pursue a change to the Kansas Essential Health Benefits Package due to a proviso in 2023 Senate Bill 25, resulting in the agency not needing federal grant monies in FY 2024. Furthermore, there is a 0.25 FTE increase due to the reclassification of a position from 0.5 FTE to 0.75 FTE.
