### **Agency Request**

The **agency** requests \$91.8 million, all from special revenue funds, in expenditures and 39.8 FTE positions for FY 2025. This is an increase of \$6.1 million, or 7.1 percent, above the FY 2024 revised estimate. This increase is primarily attributable to increases in the BUILD Kansas Matching Grant Fund (\$5.0 million) and STAR Bonds Food Sales Tax Revenue Replacement Fund (\$3.0 million).

#### **Governor's Recommendation**

The **Governor** recommends revised expenditures of \$145.4 million, all from special revenue funds, for FY 2025. This is an increase of \$53.6 million, or 58.4 percent, above the agency's FY 2024 revised estimate. This increase is primarily attributable to the Governor recommending the inclusion of \$54.0 million for the Local Ad Valorem Sales Tax Reduction Fund. This is offset by decreasing the SGF transfer to the STAR Bonds Food Sales Tax Revenue Replacement Fund by \$400,000, from \$7.7 million to \$7.3 million.

#### Senate Committee on Financial Institutions and Insurance Recommendation

The **Committee** concurs with the Governor's recommendation with the following notations:

- 1. Review at Omnibus the transfer to the STAR Bonds Food Sales Tax Revenue Replacement Fund for FY 2025.
- Review at Omnibus the transfer to Local Ad Valorem Tax Reduction Fund for FY 2025.

## **Senate Committee on Ways and Means Recommendation**

The **Committee** concurs with the Committee's recommendation with the follow adjustment:

- Add \$2.0 million SGF to the Pregnancy Compassion Awareness Program account to continue the statewide program to enhance and increase resources that promote childbirth instead of abortion to women facing unplanned pregnancies and to offer a full range of services, including pregnancy support centers, adoption assistance, and maternity homes for FY 2025.
- Delete \$54.0 million, all from the Local Ad Valorem Tax Reduction, and delete the transfer for FY 2025. Review at Omnibus the transfer to Local Ad Valorem Tax Reduction Fund for FY 2025. Add language to suspend the Local Ad Valorem Tax Reduction transfer for FY 2026, FY 2027, and FY 2028.
- 3. Add language to amend the Build Kansas Matching Grant program to allow the State Treasurer to award funds to a community which has been notified that the communities' grant application does not quality for federal matching funds under the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) after the local community has been notified by the coordinating agency and advises and consults with the Build Kansas Advisory Committee for FY 2025. FY 2026, FY 2027, and FY 2028. Current statutory provisions regarding geographical distributions of grants shall apply to grants approved by this provision.

## **Agency Request**

The **agency** requests \$91.8 million, all from special revenue funds, in expenditures and 39.8 FTE positions for FY 2025. This is an increase of \$6.1 million, or 7.1 percent, above the FY 2024 revised estimate. This increase is primarily attributable to increases in the Build Kansas Matching Grant Fund (\$5.0 million) and STAR Bonds Food Sales Tax Revenue Replacement Fund (\$3.0 million).

## **Governor's Recommendation**

The **Governor** recommends revised expenditures of \$145.4 million, all from special revenue funds, for FY 2025. This is an increase of \$53.6 million, or 58.4 percent, above the agency's FY 2024 revised estimate. This increase is primarily attributable to the Governor recommending the inclusion of \$54.0 million for the Local Ad Valorem Tax Reduction Fund. This is offset by decreasing the SGF transfer to the STAR Bonds Food Sales Tax Revenue Replacement Fund by \$400,000, from \$7.7 million to \$7.3 million.

### **House Budget Committee on General Government Recommendation**

The **Budget Committee** concurs with the Governor's recommendation for FY 2025 with the following adjustments:

- Add \$2.0 million SGF to the Pregnancy Compassion Awareness Program account to continue the statewide program to enhance and increase resources that promote childbirth instead of abortion to women facing unplanned pregnancies and to offer a full range of services, including pregnancy support centers, adoption assistance, and maternity homes for FY 2025.
- 2. Delete \$54.0 million, all from the Local Ad Valorem Tax Reduction Fund, and delete the transfer for FY 2025.
- 3. Delete \$3.0 million, all from the STAR Bonds Food Sales Tax Replacement Fund, and reduce the transfer for FY 2025.
