The business of the day was to introduce a balloon the committee on **HB 2114**, A copy of the balloon is (<u>Attachment #1</u>) attached hereto and incorporated into the Minutes by reference. The balloon was discussed with all of the lobbying parties and Kansas Division of Vehicles, Sheila Walker, before coming to the meeting and its' contents agreed upon. The motion was made by Representative Edmonds and seconded by Representative Toelkes to accept the amendment. Discussion was briefly held by Representative Kirk. The motion carried. On the bill the motion was made by Representative Edmonds to move the bill ou as amended and was seconded by Representative Grant. Vote taken and the motion carried.
