Discussion of bills

SB 89 - concerning local units of government; relating to rent control

Senator Clark moved to pass SB 89 favorable, seconded by Senator Jackson. The motion carried.

SB 171 - Governor use of aircraft travel

Natalie Haag, Chief Legal Counsel, Director of Governmental Affairs, appeared before the committee with additional information on <u>SB 171</u> (Attachment 1). Natalie briefed the committee on the proposal the Governor's office had Ken Wilke, Revisor of Statutes, draft (Attachment 2).

Senator Gooch moved to adopt the amendment striking "section 1 entirely and making a new section 1", and moved favorably as a substitute bill. Senator Schmidt seconded the motion. A division was requested and the motion passed with 5 aye and 4 nay.

A motion was made to reconsider the action on **Sub SB 171** by Senator Jackson, seconded by Senator O'Connor, requesting adopting the language on Natalie's amendment, proposed in (a) and (b) and in (c) and on line 21 strike policies and add rules and regulations.

Senator Brownlee moved to table SB 171 seconded by Senator Jackson. The motion carried
