MINUTES OF THE HOUSE WILDLIFE, PARKS AND TOURISM COMMITTEE

Chairman Myers called the meeting to order and welcomed back same committee members as last year. Committee has two carry over bills from last year and one new one so far.

Chairman Myers recognized Christopher Tymeson from the Kansas Department of Wildlife & Parks asking him to give a brief summary of what he will be briefing the committee on during our meeting of February 1. Mr. Tymeson reported that there has been an internal deer committee made up of ten individuals in the department reviewing the statutes. They plan to present their findings to this committee on February 1 along with the use of power point. The following day they plan to give a similar briefing to the Senate Natural Resources Committee. The plan is then to hold 20 to 25 public meetings across the state over the next year gaining input. Following those meetings they are hopeful of coming up with some statutory simplification regarding deer management.
