

## 2023 Kansas Statutes

**12-16,140. Certain actions by municipalities prohibited and declared null and void relating to restricting local officials from actions regarding information of citizenship.** (a) No municipality shall enact, implement or enforce an ordinance, resolution, rule or policy that prohibits or in any way restricts a law enforcement officer, local official or local government employee, from taking the following actions with regard to information of the citizenship or immigration status, lawful or unlawful, of an individual:

- (1) Communicating or cooperating with federal officials;
  - (2) sending to or receiving information from the United States department of homeland security;
  - (3) obtaining or maintaining information; or
  - (4) exchanging information with another federal, state, or local government entity.
- (b) Any ordinance, resolution, rule or policy that violates subsection (a) is null and void.
