The Discovery Center was made possible through a partnership between the City of Manhattan and the State of Kansas by utilizing a portion of a broader \$50 million STAR bond award, which was part of an overall \$200 million downtown redevelopment project in Manhattan, KS. Extending this legislation will provide municipalities with another redevelopment and economic development tool, to assist in attracting visitors to this great State, recruiting businesses, and staying competitive in Kansas.
