**Subject:** SB 300f; Extending the length of time for temporary registration and making application for title from 30 days to 60 days.

Mr. Chairman and Members of the Committee,

My name is Ray Wilk, I am the Policy and Procedure Manager for the Division of Vehicles. I am testifying for Donna Shelite, Director of Vehicles who is not available due to the death of her father this last Sunday.

Briefly, SB 300 will extend the length of time a temporary registration, commonly called a 30 day permit, and the grace period for making application for title from 30 days to 60 days.

This will benefit the purchaser of new and used vehicles by giving them additional time to save for the fees and taxes due at application time. It benefits the dealer community by allowing more time to work out any difficulties they may encounter with obtaining the previous owner's title and delivering the same to the buyer.

The Division supports the SB 300.
