US custom harvesters and its members petition the state of Kansas to change, renew transportation laws to assist our members in safer transportation of our equipment in the most time saving, safe and economic way possible. With needs to service agriculture and feed the world in the most efficient way, equipment size and harvesting capacity has grown or expanded vastly in the last few years, in order for us to be efficient and our businesses to stay competitive. We look at ways to transport our equipment through the state, the most efficient way is to have a one semi tractor, trailer, trailer combination, exceeding the current two twenty eight and one half feet, o a length of trailers only as in other states exceeding 81 feet but less than ninety including load. This for us is the safest way to move equipment never exceeding weight laws and traveling through the state less than one thousand miles annually.
