Voluntary Retirement Incentive Program

1. Adjustments to Budget Reductions

Last summer I announced the Voluntary Retirement Incentive Program, with the goal of reducing agency spending to help the state live within its means. Approximately 4,000 employees were eligible and 1,027 retired through the incentive program. In administering this program, some decisions with an impact on agency budgets were made after preparation of my original budget. To ensure agencies have the proper staffing levels, I amend my budget to

readjust several agencies that were reduced in my original budget issued last month. In total, \$1,435,495 is added as well as 29.00 FTE positions. To compensate the State General Fund for this additional expense not anticipated in my original budget, a transfer from the Department of Administration's Accounting Services Recovery Fund is also recommended so the net effect to the State General Fund will be zero.

2. Airport Incentive Funding

I amend my budget to shift \$2.0 million in my FY 2013 budget for the Department of Commerce to FY 2012. The Legislature put the original funds in the North Central Kansas Air Passenger Service Support Fund in KDOT, and because the air service in Manhattan has been successful, this money was not accessed and can now be pulled back to the Economic Development Initiatives Fund and made available. My intent is to turn that money back around within this fiscal year to make it quickly available, in the event it is needed.

3. Reorganization of State Agencies

One of the most significant cost drivers in our state budget has been Medicaid. As my team worked through the details of the agency realignment to streamline how Medicaid will be managed in Kansas, we subsequently made changes to the broader plan to accommodate legal and technical issues affecting the agencies. I therefore amend my budget to align it with Executive Reorganization Order No. 41. Although individual agency's budgets are affected as programs shift, this budget amendment totals to zero.
