Discussion and Final Action:

SB 381 -- Alcoholic beverages; authorizing sales of cereal malt beverage by a retailer licensed under the Kansas liquor control act

Staff provided an overview of the bill.

Senator Longbine made a motion to amend the bill by an adoption of a substitute bill. Senator Morris seconded the motion.

The chair asked the Revisor to explain the substitute bill.

The substitute bill would allow the Director to issue to qualified applicants a beer retailer's license; would allow the retailer's license to sell and offer for sale at retail, and deliver in the original package, beer and cereal malt beverage for use or consumption off of and away from the premises specified in such licenses. Discussion and questions followed the motion.

The motion failed. Back on the bill.

Senator Haley moved to table the bill. Senator Abrams seconded the motion.

Senator Haley withdrew his motion with permission from the second. The Committee continued to discuss the bill.
