
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2140 by House Special Committee on Legislative Streamlining

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2140 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2140 would repeal the 1994 Special Commission on Surface Water Quality Standards which has expired.

The Division of the Budget contacted the Departments of Agriculture, Health & Environment, Wildlife & Parks, and the Biological Survey at the University of Kansas and all indicated that passage of the bill would have no fiscal effect on agency operations.
