
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2147 by House Committee on Aging and Long Term Care

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2147 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2147 would increase the maximum number of individuals who could be cared for at a residence or facility and still be considered a "home plus" facility from eight persons to 12 persons.

Both the Kansas Department on Aging and the Kansas Department of Health and Environment indicate that the passage of HB 2147 would have no fiscal effect on their operations.
