
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2172 by House Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2172 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Current law requires any person applying for the original or renewal registration of a motor vehicle to sign a document, which certifies that the applicant has and will maintain the required insurance, self-insurance, or other financial security during the registration period. HB 2283 would require only those applying for the original registration of a vehicle to sign the certification.

The Department of Revenue indicates HB 2172 would have no fiscal effect on state revenues or expenditures.
