**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2495 by House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2495 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2495 would amend current law by increasing the maximum allowable cost of a three year vessel registration from \$30 to \$60.

According to the Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism, passage of HB 2495 would have no immediate fiscal effect. If the bill were to pass, the agency would then need to take regulatory action to increase the registration fee. The agency does not plan to increase the fee at this time.
