SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2552 by Representative LeDoux, et al.

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2552 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2552 would specify that school superintendents do not need to have any experience in a state accredited school, which requires the holding of a professional teaching license, a professional school specialist license, a professional clinical license, or certification in career and technical education.

Enactment of HB 2552 would have no fiscal effect.
