
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2633 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2633 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2633 concerns eligibility for Food Assistance, as it pertains to households composed of illegal immigrants and citizens. Food Assistance eligibility is composed of two income eligibility tests; a gross income test and a net income test. Under current policy, entire household income and the total number of household members is counted when determining the gross eligibility test. Then under the net income test the entire household income is applied to the number of citizens in the household to determine the amount of the benefit. HB 2633 would maintain that methodology.

HB 2633 would have no fiscal effect.
