
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2694 by Representative Siegfried

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2694 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2694 would require the Legislative Coordinating Council to reestablish an all faiths chapel in the state capitol building.

If HB 2694 were passed, no cost would be known until the Legislative Coordinating Council determined where the chapel would be and how it would be equipped and furnished. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2694 is not reflected in *The FY 2013 Governor's Budget Report*.
