SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2743 by House Committee on Appropriations

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2743 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2743 would increase the annual fee, from \$50 to \$75, that is required of every person, firm, partnership, association, or corporation, which makes, compiles or completes, and sells abstracts of title to real estate in the State of Kansas.

The Abstracter's Board of Examiners indicates that HB 2743 would increase fee revenue to the Abstracters Fee Fund in FY 2013, but did not provide an estimate. Based on historical receipts into the fund, the fees would increase by approximately \$10,000 in FY 2013. Since the Governor's recommendation included increasing fees so that the agency would remain solvent, the fiscal effect associated with HB 2743 is reflected in *The FY 2013 Governor's Budget Report*.
