SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 136 by Senate Committee on Financial Institutions and Insurance

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 136 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 136 would prohibit an individual who does not maintain the required personal injury protection coverage from collecting non-economic damages if the individual sustains injuries in an automobile accident. The bill would apply to individuals whose insurance coverage has been expired for more than 30 days.

The Kansas Insurance Department indicates that SB 136 would have no fiscal effect on its operations.
