SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 252 by Joint Committee on Administrative Rules and Regulations

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 252 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Existing law requires a period of not less than 60 days for public comment prior to the adoption of any permanent or temporary rule or regulation with the option of reducing that period to no less than 30 days. SB 252 removes that option, leaving the requirement at 60 days. The bill also makes technical corrections.

Passage of SB 252 is not expected to have a fiscal effect on state agencies.
