SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 402 by Senate Committee on Assessment and Taxation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 402 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 402 would provide a sales tax exemption for Live Free Ministries, Inc. The bill would exempt all sales taxes from the sale of property from concession machines operated or serviced by Live Free Ministries, Inc. that are used to provide housing and a structured environment for persons with an addictive background.

The Department of Revenue indicates that it is unable to release confidential taxpayer information and therefore is unable to provide an estimate of the bill's fiscal effect on state revenues.
