In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 66 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 66 would amend the Campaign Finance Act to prohibit any candidate for elected office from appearing in, or their name from being used in, a public service announcement or advertisement within 60 days of an election. The fine for violating the provisions of this bill would be up to \$1,000.

The Governmental Ethics Commission indicates SB 66 would have no fiscal effect on state revenues or expenditures.
