22 (2) "state officer" means (A) the governor, lieutenant governor, 23 attorney general, secretary of state, state treasurer, commissioner 24 of insurance, each secretary of a department or other chief 25 executive officer of a department of the executive branch, each 26 member of a board, commission, council or authority of the 27 executive branch, (B) each member of the legislature, each 28 legislative officer specified in K.S.A. 46-137b, and amendments 29 thereto, (C) each justice of the supreme court, each judge of the 30 court of appeals, each district judge, each district magistrate judge, 31 and (D) each other state officer in the executive branch, legislative 32 branch or judicial branch of state government whose position is 33 specified by statute or is otherwise determined to be a salaried 34 officer of the state as that phrase is used in section 15 of article 1 or 35 section 13 of article 3 of the constitution of the state of Kansas, and 36 in any case "state officer" includes all salaried officers of the state 37 as that phrase is used in section 15 of article 1 or section 13 of 38 article 3 of the constitution of the state of Kansas;

39 (3) "regents state agency" means the university of Kansas, the

1 university of Kansas medical center, Kansas state university, 2 Kansas state university veterinary medical center, Kansas state 3 university extension systems and agriculture research programs, 4 Wichita state university, Emporia state university, Pittsburg state 5 university and Fort Hays state university; and 6 (4) "compensation" means any salary or per diem compensation 7 provided by law for a state officer; and 8 (5) "executive branch employee" means an employee of a state 9 agency within the executive branch of state government who has an

annual rate of compensation that is equal to or more than \$100,000 for fiscal year 2011 and who is not a state officer, as defined by this section.

Sec. 52 53. Appeals to exceed expenditure limitations. (a) Upon written application to the governor and approval of the state finance council, expenditures from special revenue funds may exceed the amounts specified in this act.

(b) This section shall not apply to the state economic development
initiatives fund, the children's initiatives fund, the state water plan fund
or the Kansas endowment for youth fund, or to any account of any of
