AN ACT concerning school districts; relating to the calculation of the 1 2 local option budget; amending K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 72-6433d and repealing the existing section. 3 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 72-6433d is hereby amended to read 6 as follows: 72-6433d. (a) (1) The provisions of this subsection shall apply 7 8 in any school year in which the amount of base state aid per pupil is 9 \$4,433 or less. 10 (2) The board of any school district may adopt a local option budget which does not exceed the local option budget calculated as if the base 11 state aid per pupil was \$4,433 or which does not exceed an amount as 12 13 authorized by K.S.A. 72-6433, and amendments thereto, whichever is 14 greater. 15 (b) (1) The provisions of this subsection shall apply in any school year in which the amount appropriated for state aid for special education 16 17 and related services is less than the amount appropriated for state aid for 18 special education and related services in school year 2008-2009. 19 (2) The board of education of any school district may adopt a local 20 option budget which does not exceed the local option budget calculated 21 as if the district received state aid for special education and related 22 services equal to the amount of state aid for special education and related 23 services received in school year 2008-2009, or which does not exceed an 24 amount as authorized by K.S.A. 72-6433, and amendments thereto, 25 whichever is greater. 26 The board of education of any school district may exercise the (c) 27 authority granted under subsection (a) or (b) or both subsections (a) and 28 (b). 29 (d) To the extent that the provisions of K.S.A. 72-6433, and amendments thereto, conflict with this section, this section shall control. 30 31 (e) The provisions of this section shall expire on June 30, 2012. 32 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 72-6433d is hereby repealed. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 33 Sec. 3. publication in the statute book. 34 35
