AN ACT concerning school districts; relating to school finance; 1 2 amending K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 72-6455 and 72-6459 and repealing the 3 existing sections. 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 72-6455 is hereby amended to read as 6 follows: 72-6455. (a) (1) As used in this section, "school district" 7 means any district having: (1) (A) An enrollment of at least 50% at-risk 8 pupils: or (2) (B) an enrollment of at least 35.1% at-risk pupils and an 9 10 enrollment density of at least 212.1 pupils per square mile. 11 (b) (2) The high density at-risk pupil weighting of each school 12 district shall be determined by the state board by multiplying the number of at-risk pupils by .10. The product is the high density at-risk pupil 13 14 weighting of the district. 15 (e) (3) If a school district becomes ineligible for high density at-risk pupil weighting because enrollment of at-risk pupils in the district falls 16 below the requirements of *paragraph (1)* subsection (a), the high density 17 at-risk pupil weighting of the district shall be the greater of: (1) (A) The 18 19 high density at-risk pupil weighting in the current school year; (2) (B) the 20 high density at-risk pupil weighting in the prior school year; or (3) (C) the average of the high density at-risk pupil weighting in the current school 21 22 year and the preceding two school years. 23 The provisions of this subsection paragraph shall expire on June 30, 24 2011. 25 This subsection shall expire on June 30 immediately preceding (4) 26 the school year for which the appropriation for general state aid is sufficient in an amount to fund the base state aid per pupil at an amount 27 equal to or greater than \$4,492. 28 29 (b) (1) This subsection shall be effective on and after July 1 of the school year for which the appropriation for general state aid is sufficient 30 in an amount to fund the base state aid per pupil at an amount equal to 31 32 or greater than \$4,492.

33 (2) The high density at-risk pupil weighting of each school district
34 shall be determined by the state board as follows:

35 (A) Except as provided in subparagraph (C), if the district has an 36 enrollment of at least 35%, but less than 50% at-risk pupils, the state 1 *board shall:*

2 *(i)* Subtract 35% from the percentage of at-risk enrollment in the 3 district;

(ii) multiply the amount determined under clause (i) by .007; and

(iii) multiply the number of at-risk pupils enrolled in the district by
the product determined under clause (ii). The resulting product is the
high density at-risk pupil weighting of the district.

(B) If the district has an enrollment of 50% or more at-risk pupils,
the state board shall multiply the number of at-risk pupils by .105. The
resulting product is the high density at-risk pupil weighting of the district.

11 (C) If the district has an enrollment of at least 35.1% at-risk pupils 12 and an enrollment density of at least 212.1 pupils per square mile, the 13 state board shall multiply the number of at-risk pupils by .105. The 14 resulting product is the high density at-risk pupil weighting of the district.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 72-6459 is hereby amended to read as
follows: 72-6459. (a) As used in this section, "school district" means any
district having an enrollment of at least 40% but less than 50% at-risk
pupils.

(b) The medium density at-risk pupil weighting of each school
district shall be determined by the state board by multiplying the number
of at-risk pupils by .06. The product is the medium density at-risk pupil
weighting of the district.

23 (c) If a school district becomes ineligible for medium density at-risk 24 pupil weighting because enrollment of at-risk pupils in the district falls below the requirement of subsection (a), the medium density at-risk pupil 25 weighting of the district shall be the greater of: (1) The medium density 26 27 at-risk pupil weighting in the current school year; (2) the medium density at-risk pupil weighting in the prior school year; or (3) the average of the 28 29 medium density at-risk pupil weighting in the current school year and the 30 preceding two school years.

The provisions of this subsection shall expire on June 30, 2011.

(d) This section shall expire on June 30 immediately preceding the
school year for which the appropriation for general state aid is sufficient
in an amount to fund the base state aid per pupil at an amount equal to
or greater than \$4,492.

36 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 72-6455 and 72-6459 are hereby 37 repealed.
