HOUSE BILL No. 2078

An Act concerning the state school for the blind and the state school for the deaf; relating to training programs; amending K.S.A. 76-1102a and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

New Section 1. The state board of education is hereby authorized to establish and conduct at the Kansas state school for the deaf, a training program for deaf persons. Tuition, fees and charges for services provided shall be set by the state board.

- Sec. 2. K.S.A. 76-1102a is hereby amended to read as follows: 76-1102a. The state board of education is hereby authorized to establish and conduct at the Kansas state school for the blind, a summer training program for blind persons. Tuition, fees, and charges for maintenance and the length of the summerprogram services provided shall be set by said the state board.
