4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
5	Section 1. (a) No state officer or employee shall be employed in any
6	capacity or receive any compensation for any work which involves at
7	least 10 hours per week performed by such state officer or employee
8	other than such state officer's or employee's official duties.
9	(b) For the purposes of this section, the term "state officer or
10	employee" includes the following:
11	(1) The governor;
12	(2) the attorney general;
13	(3) the secretary of state;
14	(4) the commissioner of insurance;
15	(5) the state treasurer;
16	(6) each person appointed to the governor's cabinet;
17	(7) the public information officer and the chief attorney appointed for
18	the:
19	(A) Department of administration;
20	(B) department on aging;
21	(C) department of agriculture;
22	(D) department of commerce;
23	(E) department of corrections;
24	(F) department of health and environment;
25	(G) department of social and rehabilitation services;
26	(H) department of transportation;
27	(1) Kansas department of wildlife and parks; and
28	(2) commissioner of juvenile justice;
29	(8) the personal secretary and one special assistant to the:
30	(A) Secretary of administration;
31	(B) secretary on aging;
32	(C) secretary of agriculture;
33	(D) secretary of commerce;
34	(E) secretary of corrections;
35	(F) secretary of health and environment;
36	(G) secretary of social and rehabilitation services;

- (H) secretary of transportation;(I) secretary of wildlife and parks; and(K) commissioner of juvenile justice.(c) Any person who violates this act shall be deemed to be guilty of a class A misdemeanor.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
